“Addressing Nutritional and Income Insecurity of Underprivileged Communities by Improving Access to Information on Relevant Government Schemes”

In collaboration with Agramee & European Union AGRANEE has been implementing the above mentioned project in Kaptipada block. Five GPs namely Nota, Saradiha, Sarat, Ranipokhari & Dewanbahali are covered under this project. This is basically on Information Sharing by Public Authorities under Section 4.1(b) of the Right to Information (RTI) Act. Improve quality of life of poor local communities in remote tribal pockets by enhancing participation in local governance, and improving information and access to Govt. schemes.

In between we have completed 2nd year of the project out of five year project period. As per plan we have established a Block Information Centre for Kaptipada block at village Dileswar from where people can easily access to information on different government schemes & programmes. Two major citizen forums namely Citizen Action Group at block level and district Right to Information have been formed & functionalised to address common/local issues actively as well as ensure people’s participation in government programmes like- primary education & health, nutrition, MGNREGA and self governance etc.

Apart from BIC some of the major activities undertaken during the year are block level CAG & district level RTI forum meetings and organizing information sharing /distribution camps in weekly local market places known as Hata Programme.

Though regularity of children in school & AWC is not so encouraging but 100% enrolment is achieved so far our project action area is concerned. Though few steps have been taken towards ensuring 100 days work to all job seekers but not yet fulfilled. Also some extent we have achieved success in ensuring people's especially women participation in local self governance system i.e. Palli Sabha & Gram Sabha.

Solar Electrification for Domestic Lighting

After completion of the initial project work titled "Solar Electrification for Domestic Lighting" supported by MANTHAN, Rajasthan was formally inaugurated on 2nd of December 2015 by Mr. Arindam Dakua, IAS, Project Director DRDA, Mayurbhanj along with BDO, Thakurmunda and some of the eminent local elected representatives / village leaders. Mr. Achyut Das,

Director Agramee, Odisha chaired the session and Executive Secretary, AGRANEE, Mayurbhanj shared the aim, objectives & procedure of implementation of the project in details.

Under this project AGRANEE has electrified a total of 200 mostly BPL households belongs to tribal community by solar power in three identified non-greed villages/hamlets namely Saparamgutu under Debanbahali GP & Serengsahi under Saradiha GP of Kaptipada block and Mandaljhari village under Keshdiha GP of Thakurmunda block of Mayurbhanj district Odisha. One system (one SPV panel of 40 watts, one tubular battery 12 volts, one electronic charge controller 10 amps, two CFL lamps of 9 watts each & other accessories etc.) for each family has been provided under this project.

Alternative Vaccine Delivery System

This was the fifth continuation year of the project and activities undertaken similar to previous years. Under this assignment Agranee had taken the responsibility of delivering vaccine at 92 session sites of Karanjia block covering all 22 ANM sub-centres as part of routine immunization activities under NRHM. Giving necessary orientation, we have deployed six local boys dividing the entire block in six routes for smooth implementation of the AVDS under the terms and conditions specified in the signed agreement by both the parties.
